Women's Wall of Fame Nomination Criteria/Timeline

Nominees must be women who:

- Live and/or work in San Luis Obispo County, or
- Have played an integral part in the development and/or implementation of project(s) that have benefited San Luis Obispo County
- <u>NOTE</u>: Members of the San Luis Obispo County Commission for Women (Commission) and the Board of Supervisors are not eligible for nomination.

Areas of Nomination:

- **Volunteer**: Service is voluntary and not a part of nominees job description
- **Business**: The nominee provided exemplary service during the operation of her
- work or business
- **Service**: The nominee provided exemplary service to the community during her

employment in a service profession (medical, social, government, legal,

educational, philanthropic, etc.)

Tips for completing the nomination form:

- Respond to all questions.
- Keep answers short, concise, and clear yet detailed
- Tell the nominee's story as if you were telling a stranger. Remember the judges will not know your nominee.
- Nominee may not be nominated in more than one category.
- **Please attach a high-resolution photo of your nominee** to be used in the program and slide show during the Luncheon.

Timeline:

- Completed nomination packets are due to the Commission by <u>December 15, 2017</u>
- Names of the top Honorees to be announced in February 2018
- Wall of Fame Awards Luncheon is March 10, 2018 at the Madonna Inn in San Luis Obispo
- Recognition at a San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors Meeting in April 2018
