SBWN Educational Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. Female; minimum 21 years of age
- 2. Must be a re-entry student (see definition below)
- 3. No prior degree, including an Associate Degree (AA or AS); certification is acceptable
- 4. Must be a part or full time student attending Cuesta College

A re-entry student, defined in the educational system, is one who attends college following an interuption in their post-high school education. The student either did not attend college after high school or the student started a degree but was unable to complete it.
