### **Donation Guidelines:**

- 1. Please ensure that all gifts are self-contained (i.e., if there are several parts to the gift, they should be enclosed in a basket or a gift bag. Please do not bring loose items.)
- 2. FORMS: Please fill out the 3-part donation sheet legibly and completely. Note that it's very important to write in a good description of the gift, especially the contents of gift baskets. The benefit gift coordinators will not have time to do this before the Holiday Dinner & Benefit.
- The BOTTOM sheet give to donor as a receipt.
- 4. The TOP 2 sheets turn in with the gift to Gila for organizing.
- Please ask the donor for two (2) business eards. Attach (1) to gift, (1) to donation form.
